Reader's Workshop	Next week we will read the book Scaredy Squirrel to work on reading comprehension strategies. I will continue to send home books next week too!
Writer's Workshop	We will be working adding punctuation to our sentences and writing letters for most consonant and vowel sounds when we write. We will focus on getting sounds in the beginning, middle, and end of our words.
Math	We will learn to classify and count data. We will spend time counting data to tell how many and comparing sets to practice less than, more than, greater than, and fewer.
