LEARNING GOALS

Reader's Workshop	Next week we will switch gears and be looking at a lot of non-fiction texts. We will look at text features and how it differs from fiction books. We will also read Creepy Carrots
Writer's Workshop	We will stretch and write down the sounds we hear. We will make our pictures match our words.
Math	We will finish up Topic 3 and start Topic 4 next. We will compare numbers to 10. We will focus on learning to compare groups by using the words fewer, less than, and greater than. We will also talk about equal groups.
Letter Work	This week, we will work on learning the letters K and Z. Students will need to recognize and tell the sound of each letter capital and lowercase.
Science	We will observe and describe daily weather and describe general weather conditions associated with the summer. We will use our senses to discover how daylight changes.
Social Studies	We will describe the character traits of role models within our school or family. We are working to identify the flag as a symbol of our nation. We will describe the roles and responsibilities of people in authority in families and in groups. We are practicing reciting the pledge in morning gym.
